How do I enrol on the course?

You can download the application form on our website.

or phone Kidogo Art Institute on 9335 9636 and we will post you an application form.

You will be required to have an interview and present a portfolio as part of the entrance requirements. If you have any queries about this please do not hesitate to call us on 9335 9636.

Where will the course take place?

As a student of Kidogo Art Institute, you will be having the majority of the lectures at the Kidogo Arthouse studio. In addition, there will be some excursions to art galleries, artists' studios which students will be notified of before the event.

How long does the course last?

The course is 2 semesters. It runs from February to December (coinciding with the school holiday schedule).

Do I need to bring my own materials?

We will provide some materials for workshops run by Kidogo but students are expected to supply any additional materials that may be required.

What is the cost of the course?

It is \$9,500 for the entire course. This must be paid at the time of your acceptance onto the course to secure your place. No refunds will be given.

How many lectures are there a week and how long is each lecture?

A timetable will be discussed with you prior to commencement of the course.

Can I use Kidogo after lecture hours to continue my work?

Yes this will be arranged at the start of your course.

How will my qualification be presented?

At the end of the course you will receive a Certificate IV in Visual Arts and Contemporary Craft which will be presented to you by Joanna Robertson.
