

FAQs for Adult Short Courses:

How do I enroll and when can I start?

You can start your 6 week course at anytime as the classes on a rolling basis. To enroll you can either fill out a booking form ([link to booking form](#)) and email back to us at info@creativecourses.com or phone Kidogo Art Institute on 9335 9636. Payment will need to be made upfront to secure a place.

What do I need to bring?

Your creative thoughts and any materials you have. We have brushes and equipment here that can be used during the lesson. We also sell a range of paints, brushes, paper and canvases. We have tea and coffee making facilities here which you are welcome to use.

What happens if I am unable to attend one of my classes?

If you are unable to attend a class for any reason, you will forfeit that class from your 6 week block. We are unable to offer you a refund in this instance.

What happens if a class is cancelled by Kidogo?

If we cancel a class we will offer you a make-up class, either on an alternative day (i.e. Wednesday, Friday or Sunday class) or add one on to the end of your block of 6.

Can I leave my work in the studio?

We have limited storage at Kidogo, but if you can find at space to put your canvas you are welcome to leave it during your 6 week course. We are unable to keep any work that is not taken home at the end of your course.

If after the 6 weeks I would like to continue can I?

You are very welcome to book in for another 6 weeks, we have students that have been coming for years and some who just do the 6 weeks.

Who will be my tutors?

Your tutors will be Joanna Robertson (Friday) and Pam Brittain (Wednesday/Sunday) they are both practicing artists with a wealth of knowledge of techniques and mediums. ([link to tutors page](#))
