



Aboriginal Course FAQs

How do I enroll?

How much does it cost to do the course?

Students will be charged the standard VET fees of \$285 per semester (concession) or \$570 per semester (no concession).

If you have a Centrelink concession card your fees will be \$285 per semester.

The 'Unemployed persons exempt from course fees' regulation brought in on 1 July 2009 entitles the student to be fully exempt from course fees if they can provide the following information:

14. Unemployed persons exempt from course fees

(1) In this regulation —

Job Services Australia provider means an organisation contracted by the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations of the Commonwealth to provide Job Support services to job seekers;

unemployed person means a person who holds —

(a) a Health Care Card issued by Centrelink that identifies the person as being in receipt of the Newstart Allowance; or

(b) a Health Care Card issued by Centrelink that identifies the person as being in receipt of the Youth Allowance — Jobseeker; or

(c) a Job Services identification card issued by Centrelink or by a Job Services Australia provider that includes a job seeker identification number.

In cases of extreme hardship, where the student does not hold the relevant Centrelink card to comply with the regulation, a fee waiver will be assessed by Kidogo Art Institute.



Can I apply for Abstudy?
